




Permit

The EHSdesk™ **Environment - Permit** module maintains and tracks permits, licenses, orders, and registration information. Responsible persons and organizations are assigned along with the appropriate governing agency and regulatory references. Permits may be related to Notice of Violations (NOVs) tracked in the Corrective Action Request (CAR) module. Permit expiration and renewal dates automatically feed the calendar portion of the Planning & Calendar Manager (PACmgr) module providing automatic e-mail notifications.

Features and Functionality

- Data for air, water, waste, hazardous waste transportation, and other configurable types is documented for permits, licenses, orders, and registrations
- Permit information may be linked to other related data sources in EHSdesk (equipment, stacks, drains, fuel burning sources, or paint booths)



- Proactive e-mail notifications are setup for the permit renewal and expiration dates placed on the PACmgr calendar
- Multiple federal, state, and/or local regulations/laws may be assigned to the permit
- Any NOVs issued against the permit may be linked via the CAR module
- Typical users include EHS Professionals
